Josh Lanyon kann mit FAIR PLAY wieder einmal zeigen, warum er zu den Besten im Bereich M/M-Romances gehört. Der Roman ist spannend, humorvoll und die Beziehung zwischen Tucker und Elliot entwickelt sich kontinuierlich weiter. Elliot lernt während seinen interessanten Nachforschungen einige völlig neue Seiten an seinem Vater kennen und er muss sich nicht nur mit dem Bild, das er von seinem Vater gehabt hat, auseinandersetzen sondern auch mit ihrer Beziehung zueinander.
