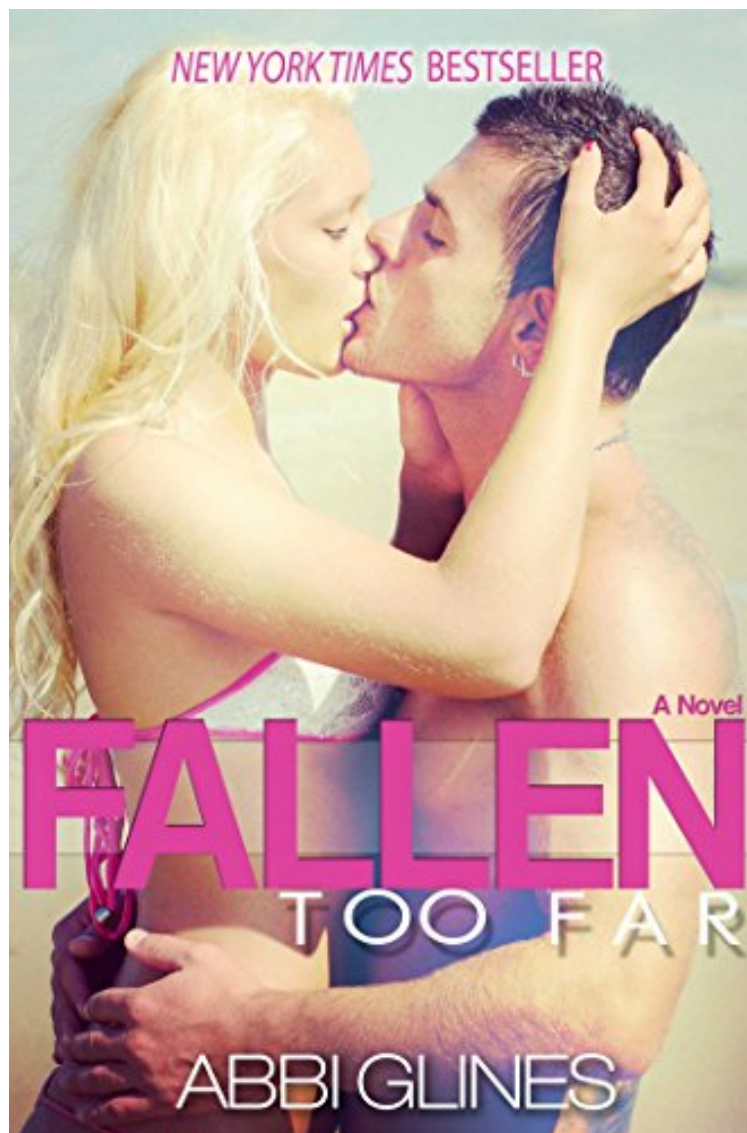

New Adult Genre mag: Drama, Missverständnisse, etwas hin und her usw. Jedoch konnte ich mich überhaupt nicht mit den Bchern anfreunden. Die Detailhandlung gibt einfach zu wenig her. Die Charaktere bleiben unheimlich oberflächlich. Die Entwicklung einer Beziehung zwischen Rush und Blaire war für mich in keiner Weise nachvollziehbar. Und die erotischen Szenen fand ich sehr langweilig. Nachdem ich mich gerne qule und die Seitenanzahl berücksichtigt war, habe ich trotzdem alle drei Bnde gelesen - auch in der Hoffnung, dass die Story vielleicht doch noch besser werden würde. Leider war das Gegenteil der Fall. Welches junge Mädchen oder auch Frau wünscht sich nicht so einen "Bad Boy!" a la Rush. Also diese beiden gehen zu meinen Lieblings Couples ever im Bereich der YA Books. Zum Inhalt gibt es eigentlich nicht viel im Vorfeld zu schreiben: Blair ist 19 und steht nach dem Tod ihrer jahre lang schwer kranken Mutter allein und Obdachlos da (sie musste das Haus ihrer Familie verkaufen um die Medikamenten Rechnung ihrer Mutter bezahlen zu können). Sie macht sich auf den Weg zu ihrem Vater und seiner neuen Frau, um bei ihnen unterkommen zu können und um dort einen Job zu finden und auf eigenen Fen stehen zu können. Dort angekommen muss Blair aber leider feststellen das ihr Vater bei den Sommer verreist ist und nur der 24-jährige Sohn seiner Frau da ist. Rush ist der Bad Boy schlecht hin, Sohn eines Rockstars, an jedem kleinen Finger eine Frau und zu Blairs entsetzen geht ihm auch noch das Haus. Rush ist mal so gar nicht amused bei Blairs erscheinen und schmeißt sie anfänglich raus, erkennt jedoch Blairs Notlage (ihr Auto ist auch noch kaputt gegangen) und lässt sie doch für eine Nacht in einem kleinen Raum unter der Treppe übernachten. Und hier beginnt die Geschichte der Beiden... Also das Buch ist kurzweilig (ich hatte leider in 5 Stunden durch), flüssig und mit einigen unerwarteten Wendungen geschrieben. Es gibt Klischees, es gibt Eifersucht, es gibt Sex (ja aber es ist keine Erotikbuch), es wird gefeiert, gelogen und am Ende gibt es einen bösen Cliffhanger. Beide Charaktere entwickeln sich, auch wenn Blair am Ende sowas von die Reisleine zieht und austickt als sie das Top Secret schlechthin rausfindet, ganz ehrlich ich hatte genauso getan. Rush ist einfach nur zum dahin schmelzen gewesen, ach ja, ich hab mich ja auch so ein bisschen in ihn verliebt, keine Ahnung wie man ihn beschreiben soll, sexy, dominant und auf jeden Fall so was von fürsorglich, Bad Boy Macho eben ;-). Selbst die anderen Charaktere die ich am Anfang mal so gar nicht leiden konnte, z.B. Woods, Blairs späterer Chef, habe ich im Laufe des Buches sogar gemocht und hatte Respekt vor ihm, anfangs undenkbar. Viel will ich eigentlich nicht über das Buch schreiben, ich würde alles verraten, und die Stimmung und Überraschungen verderben. Fazit: Ich hab gelacht, sowas von geheult, ich war geschockt, ich war verliebt und ich hatte Herzschmerz, somit 5 Sterne. Kurz: ich liebe Emotionen, ich hatte Emotionen. The teasers the author posted on her blog were steamy and looked promising. Let's start with the good things. I liked the characters in general, though they don't deliver anything special but remain very stereotypical: a young innocent gorgeous girl with parental issues and an a bit older again gorgeous guy with six-pack, money and a (bad) ass attitude. Chemistry- check, restraint and inability to act out on their wishes- check (love stories about forbidden fruit are always the best for me). There were enough hot and steamy scenes between Rush and Blaire to keep my attention. The beginning of the story was captivating, esp. the part with the gun, but unfortunately it didn't last very long for me. There is a simple "law of attraction" between me and any book - in comparison to real life, fiction should make sense. Just bringing events in some strange order to create tension and suspension is definitely not enough. This book was full of WTHs and Whys for me. Blaire arrives at the house where her father supposedly waits for her. She has nothing but her truck and clothes. The house belongs to her step-brother, who seems to hate her at once. But despite his attitude and hate talk he is so gorgeous and sexy that she can't stop thinking of him. Blaire is allowed to live in Rush's house but tries to find her own footing and gets a job in the country club. And here the plot just goes down. I didn't like this black-white description of rich people and blue-collar workers (rich-ultimately bad and working people- perfectly good). It was just too extreme for my taste. After saying maybe 3 or 4 sentences to each other and seeing each other 2 times, Rush suddenly proclaims himself a bad guy and warns Blaire to stay away from him. WHY?!! She hasn't even shown him any signs! Then there was this strange notion of age difference: Rush is 24 and Blaire is 19. 5 years difference, both are adults and pretty mature. Still Rush behaves in such a way as if he were trying to seduce a 16-year-old being 40 himself. The next absolutely unexplainable thing is Nan's secret. Nan is Rush's younger sister who hates Blaire at sight. She is also very gorgeous, but bitchy. As it appears everyone knows why Nan hates Blaire but neither Nan, nor Rush nor a bunch other people tell Blaire this. But everyone makes a big deal out of this secret. WTH?!! Nan doesn't even try to say anything in that direction to Blaire. Confusing and unreal. When the secret is that big, there would be no way the person like Nan would keep her mouth shut. I still do not get it why Rush regards himself as a bad person (though it is partly explained in the blurb). Well I can't really say the book was bad but it was not that good either. Cage's and Preston's ones are still my favorites. I will give 5 stars for the hot-factor, but 2,5-3 for the plot itself. My personal idea of a good read is a smooth flowing through the story, and not stumbling around all the time asking "what the hell is happening and why?". I hope the second book will deliver more

sense and less WTHs.
