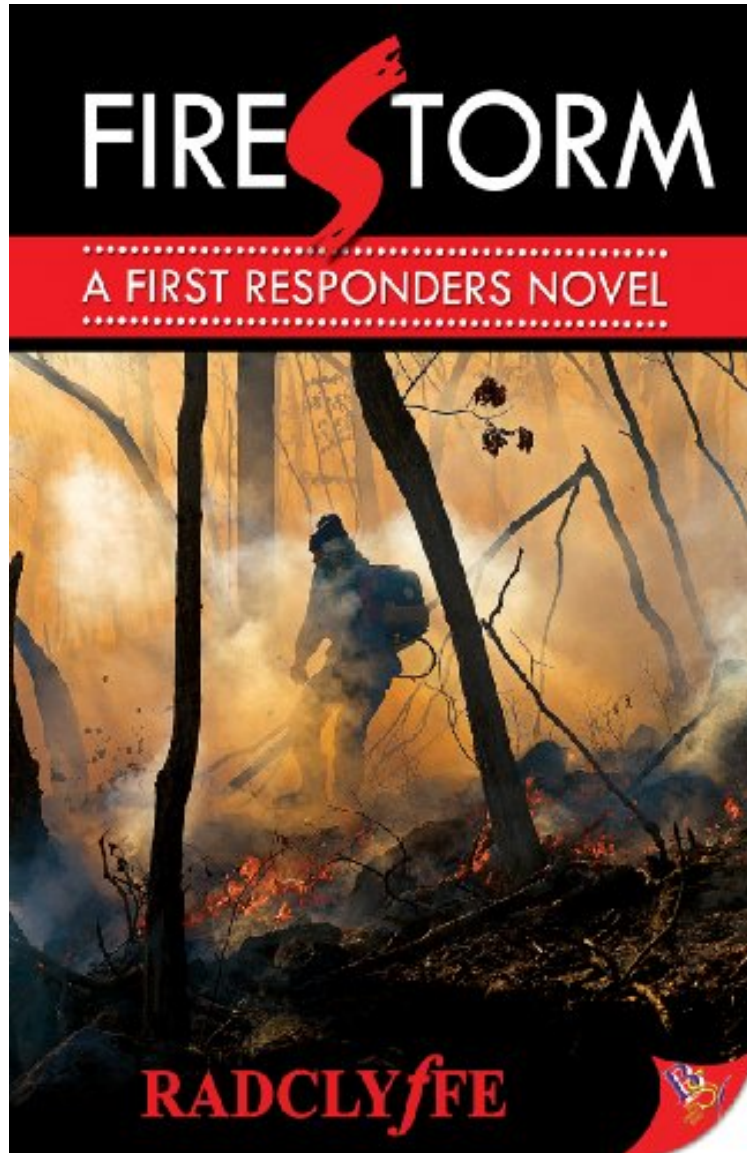

DisappointingVon Sandra"Firestorm" is the second book in Radyclyffe's First Responder series.30-year-old Mallory "Ice" James is the captain of a smokejumper crew and about to train a new group of rookies. A year ago, she lost two

of her people in a fire and she's determined to keep control this year. Under no circumstances does she want to have even friendly feelings for another firefighter. Her well-ordered life is interrupted when a new rookie is transferred without her knowledge. Jac Russo is the daughter of a senator and determined to prove herself. When they meet, there's an instant attraction, but not necessarily an instant liking of each other. Technically, the book is well-written with good editing and the head hopping is so controlled that it's not annoying. But I didn't feel close to any of the characters. The ending felt rushed, for example, the situation with Jac's father was never resolved. I also expected to have them fight a fire and Mallory overcoming her self-doubts after losing two of her men, but it didn't happen. If you have never read one of Radclyffe's books before, I suggest you read "Safe Harbor" or "Turn Back Time," not "Firestorm."

Leichte Kost nach Schema F Von Koboldmaki Diesen Roman zu kritisieren, weil er den gnigen Mustern einer seichten Romanze folgt, erscheint mir falsch. Es gibt da eben nicht viel Spielraum innovativ zu sein: Sie treffen sich, sie mgen sich (oder auch nicht), es ergeben sich Probleme (innere oder uere Konflikte), selbige werden (mehr oder weniger) geschickt gelst und dann finden sie zusammen (auf die eine oder andere Weise). Radclyffe setzt dieses Muster mal besser, mal schlechter um. Hier ist es so lala. Was einfach daran liegt, dass die Charaktere recht flach sind und die Konflikte, die doch recht drastisch sind, einfach zu oberflchlich behandelt werden. Dafr wird das "Zusammenfinden"/ "mgen oder nicht" bis ins Kleinste seziert, da man aber wei wie es endet, ist das einfach nicht so spannend. Deutlich spannender wre es gewesen, wenn Radclyffe die Konflikte etwas mehr ausgeweidet htte, dann htte man vielleicht zwischendurch mal temporr am erwartbaren Ende gezweifelt. Was Radclyffe, wie immer, gut umsetzt sind Stimmung und Setting. Man ist sehr schnell drin in dieser "Welt" und fhlt sich wohl, kennt sich aus. Man steht in diesem Fall sprichwrtlich im Wald, wobei ich zustimmen muss: Firestorm und dann eine Lawine? Naja. Ich versteht die Metaphorik des Titels ja, aber ich htte ein Feuer doch dramatischer gefunden. Wo man auch, wie immer, geteilter Meinung sein darf: Lust auf den ersten Blick. Da geht es doch schon relativ zgig zur Sache. Wenigstens liest es sich weder wie ein medizinisches Fachbuch noch wie ein billiger Porno. Man knnte es dennoch um, ich sage mal ... ca. eine halbe Seite pro Akt krzen und dafr die oben genannten Bereiche (Charaktere, Konflikte) etwas mehr aufdrseln. Dadurch wrde das Buch gewinnen. Aber es mag ja Leser(innen) geben, die Radclyffe aufgrund besagter Seiten lesen, die sind hier auf jeden Fall bestens aufgehoben.
