Review on Fitting In (Book 1) by Silvia Violet Von iris I had been looking for a M/M/M story that wasn't set in the shape shifter realm and discovered Silvia Vilote's series with the contemporary Durham/NC police setting quite some time ago. Then I caught myself re-reading and enjoying the books, so I decided the series deserves a positive review, to let the

author know how well her work has succeeded in creating a world you can escape to right from chapter one. The first sentence Two cops walk into a bar, and Mason was waiting for the punch line has become one of my most memorable catchy book start lines. With the cops Gray and Jack and bartender Mason Ms Violet has created 3 men in a deep connection I haven't found in any other M/M/M book setting so far. She does not just throw her MC s together, have mind blowing sex and then the book is finished. Her MC s have a lot of work to do to, especially as all three are lacking terribly in the communication department! Gray and Jack are already in a committed relationship but also deep in the closet to keep trouble and harassment out of their police force work lives. Mason is out, banned from his family and working as bartender since dropping out of collage to make ends meet. When Gray and Jack meet Mason in the course of their ongoing investigation both men are pulled towards the younger man instantly. Mason also feels the attraction but needs a long time believing there is more involved than just sex. A threesome maybe good for hard, hot sex but not for a functioning relationship, that's what Mason (and the reader) thinks. We have a first row seat to follow Mason and all his longings, insecurities and fears in this first volume. Thanks to the author's eloquent description skills the MC s gain so many facets and emotions that they really feel alive. Her fluent writing style just adds to not putting down the story before the last page. A menage that's not purely sexual? That sounded different. And it is. It is clear from the beginning that Gray and Jack are genuinely nice guys who appreciate Mason not purely for the fun factor of having a threesome. Mason simply can't believe that they mean it, that they want him in their life, in a relationship that's so committed and warm. To be honest, nor did I. Why would they? I can see why Mason falls in love with them. Apart from being good guys in every respect, they are also incredibly hot, and as for the sex - it is off the 'hot-factor' charts. But Gray and Jack? What is it about Mason that makes them like him than any other guy? I would have loved to find out WHY Jack and Gray are falling in love with Mason. They care about him, yes. I get that. But caring and falling in love is not quite the same. I would have loved a glimpse into Gray's head in particular to figure out what he sees in Mason. He seems very put out when Mason (supposedly) rejects them. Why? Changing POV would have helped here, no doubt, but it seems this issue will remain a mystery, as the second book in the series is about Jack and the third one isn't about any of the three. But I loved Gray most out of the three. His grumpy, quiet, bear-type personality which hides a vulnerable guy underneath. I loved Gray and would have been really keen to find out what his deal was. I think Mason's concerns about a three-way relationship are totally justified. I would have the same worries and doubts he has. But because we only get his POV we never find out why the other two fall in love with him. I found Mason a bit wearing at times - being highly insecure about Jack and Gray's intentions (I can't blame him for that, these two are definitely a tightly knit couple) he keeps repeating himself quite a bit and to me he did come across as a bit whiny. So much for the relationship part. As for the sex - it was very hot. Very. That final scene did leave me rather stunned - and very hot and bothered. *g* Despite that, I can do no more than give it three average stars. For me a lot seemed to be missing. More explanations, more in depth character studies. What I got was a string of porn-like sex scenes (with a touch of BDSM) and shallow dialogues in-between - and lots of Mason's neverending worries about being with two guys and destroying their relationship. Unfortunately, Jack and Gray remain absolutely shallow characters who only seem interested in sex (the I love yous in the end came out of the blue after an only sex-based relationship). Jack is a good cook and the mediator, Gray is dominant and not good with words - that's about as far as it goes if you don't count dick size or muscles or sex noises as descriptions. So, if you want a soft porn-like description of sex with three men in various positions: go for it. If you expect more from a book: stay clear.
