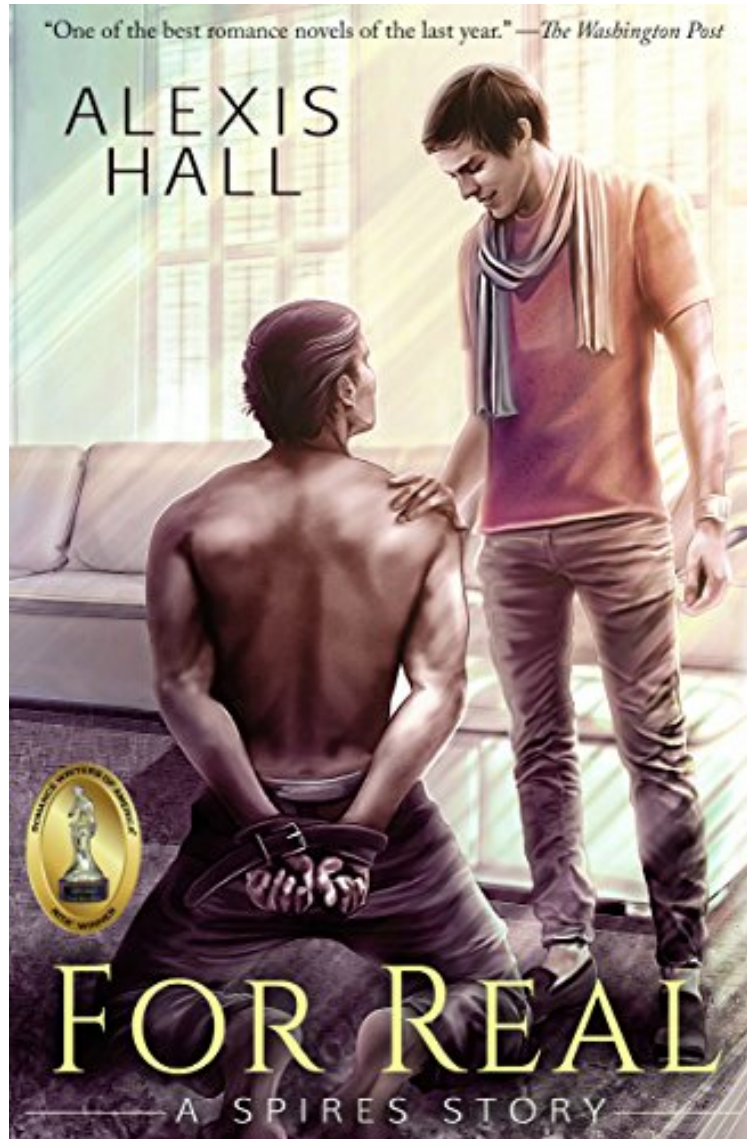

A book like this, so full of wisdom and insight, sweetness, hope, pain, growth and braveness and sheer plain awesome should light up the sky from the top of NY Times Bestseller list or something instead of "just" brightening our small corner of the reading world like the shiny gem it is. Okay, it has sex--lots of it in fact, and mostly of the kinky, dirty, terminally hot variety. But there's so much more to it. So very authentic character voices.
