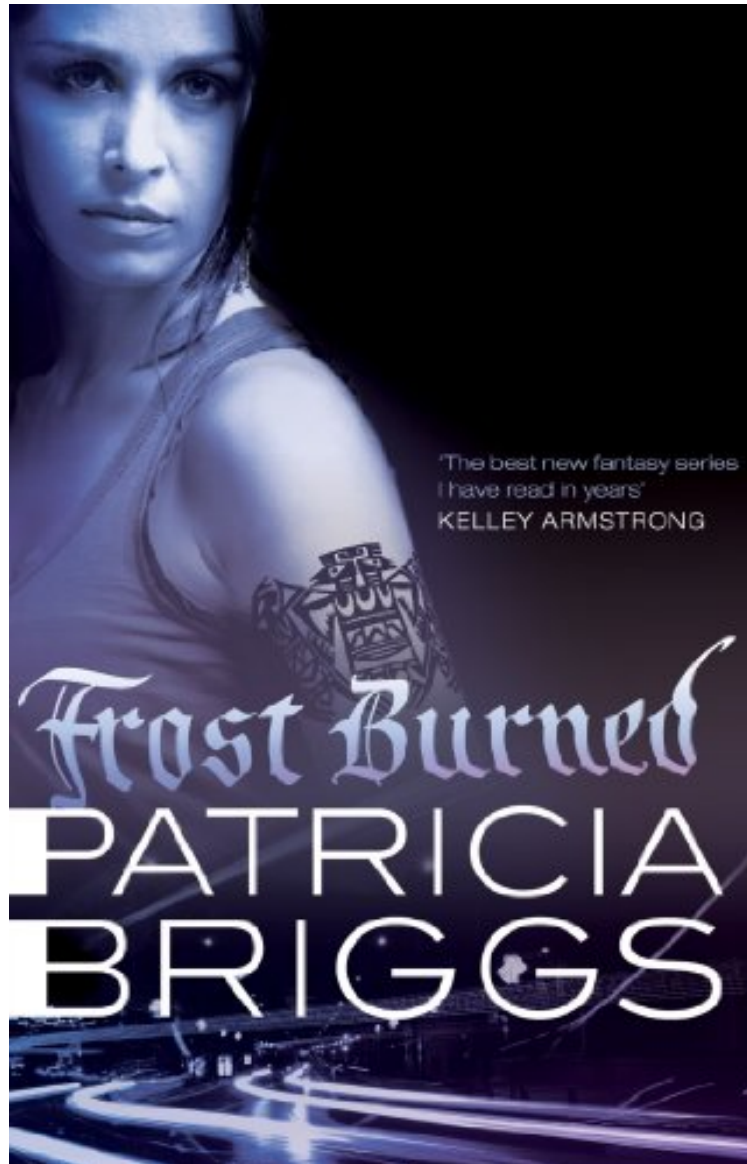

Mercy, wie wir sie kennen Von Isegrimm Mercy Thompson ist wieder da und erfreulicherweise besinnt sie sich auf ihre Wurzeln. Nachdem es in River marked ja manchmal doch arg spirituell zugeht, sind hier die guten alten Konflikte

gefragt. Mercy hat sich kaum von den Verletzungen erholt, die sie bei ihrem letzten Abenteuer erlitt, da steckt sie schon im nächsten Schlamassel. Plötzlich ist das Rudel wie vom Erdboden verschwunden, sie spürt, dass Adam Schmerzen hat und sie hat keine Ahnung, wem sie trauen kann. Mercy muss ihr Möglichstes tun, um ihre Familie und Freunde zu retten. Sehr schön, das sind Verwicklungen, wie wir sie von Patricia Briggs gewohnt sind. Sowohl Mercys Feinde als auch ihre Freunde sind gefährlich, grtenteils nichtmenschlich und mächtig. Da sie auch nicht zimperlich sind, geht es in Frost Burned manchmal ganz schön zur Sache. Da wird geschossen, erstochen, gebissen und gemordet und das aus unterschiedlichen Gründen. Schliesslich trifft der Leser nicht nur auf Werwölfe, sondern auch auf Vampire, Fae und Geister. Berraschend eigentlich, dass nicht immer die berrnatrlichen Wesen die Monster sind. Immerhin, sie sind schlimm genug und ihre Motive ebenso. Daher muss Mercy umso mehr auf der Hut sein, damit sich nicht berr Ohr gehauen wird, denn das htte nicht nur fr sie ble Konsequenzen. Frost Burned ist ungemein spannend, berraschend und packend. Frau Briggs versteht ihr Handwerk und es ist dem Roman anzumerken, dass sie sich wieder mehr Zeit fr ihre Bcher nimmt. Es tut den Geschichten gut. Fr den Leser ist es ein Vergngen, auf alte Bekannte zu treffen und in Mercys Welt einzutauchen. Was mich nicht ganz so begeistert hat, waren die Kapitel aus Adams Sicht. Sicher, man erfahrt dadurch mehr, aber da der Perspektivwechsel nicht durchgngig im Buch vorkommt, war ich damit nicht allzu glcklich. Das trifft auch auf die Hinweise, dass der Coyote trickst und tuscht, zu. Ja, ja, Mercy ist indianischer Abstammung, aber fr einen kurzen Moment hatte ich Sorge, dass Frau Briggs ihrer Heldin noch Superkrfte verpasst. Zum Glck hat sie davon abgesehen und Mercy bleibt eine sympathische Heldin mit Schwchen. Das macht das Buch nmlich so lesenswert. 2 von 2 Kunden fanden die folgende Rezension hilfreich. Definitely better than the last one Von Valkyrie Kane After River Marked, which definitely wasnt one of my favourite books, Frost Burned returns to the already known recipe: Mercy + imminent danger + most of her friends = great read. And it works perfectly. This time Ben and especially Kyle get a bigger part, and if I hadnt loved them to pieces already, I would have from this book on. Unfortunately, we also lose one of Adams pack, and though he wasnt one of the major players and had never been around all that much its quite a tragedy, because he was a nice, gentle character, whom I really liked a lot. To keep the balance at least for a little while we get introduced to a new character, which Patricia Briggs transferred temporarily from her Alpha Omega series: Asil. He makes for a really interesting addition, even if I couldnt tell which side he was actually on. Or better, what his agenda actually was. Yes, Bran sent him to help, but that wouldnt have mattered much had Asil decided to go against Mercy Co., would it? Anyway. Interesting character. As is Wulfe, btw, who also makes a brief appearance again. Mercy finally has a chance to clear things up a bit with Gabriels mother (Sorry, I keep forgetting her name. Sylvia?) and Tad gets to help with some things, too. Zee cant help all that much (at least not officially, but he does his best), because apparently one of the Gray Lords killed a senators son off-screen (Or maybe in one of P.B.s other books?), and the Fae are now cut off from the rest of the world and forced to live in their reservation(s). And I still hate Marsilia and think she deserves to die. Yes, a bird in the hand and all that, but shes absolutely odious nevertheless. So. Why four stars and not five? Because, once again, in the final fight, Mercy saves not only the day but pretty much everybody else, too. Okay, Wulfe and Marsilia get to help a little, but mostly it all depends on Mercy, her new-found ability to redeem ghosts via her infamous lamb necklace and an incredibly dangerous Fae sword that could turn on its owner at any given time and behaves just as docile as its supposed to do. Plus, theres once more a lot of I-can-do-that-because-Im-a-coyote magical hand waving. It just rubs me the completely wrong way. But well Other than that its a very good read and never gets boring. Slight deductions in the E-grade, but nothing too serious. And last but not least: this book may have 308 pages, the story, however, does not. No, thats not an euphemism for totally boring; I mean that quite literally. The story itself is 292 pages long.
