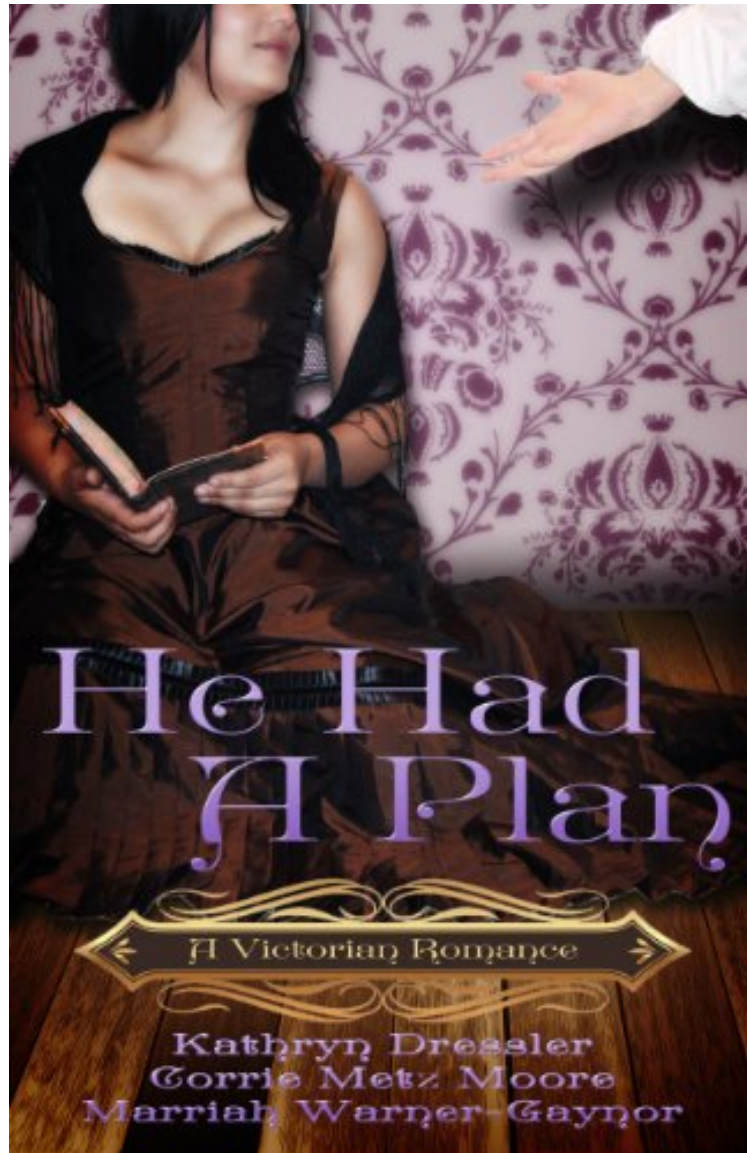

The eldest, Aster, has lived a reclusive life in the country the past 10 years, after duelling with Mr. Kuntsworth.
