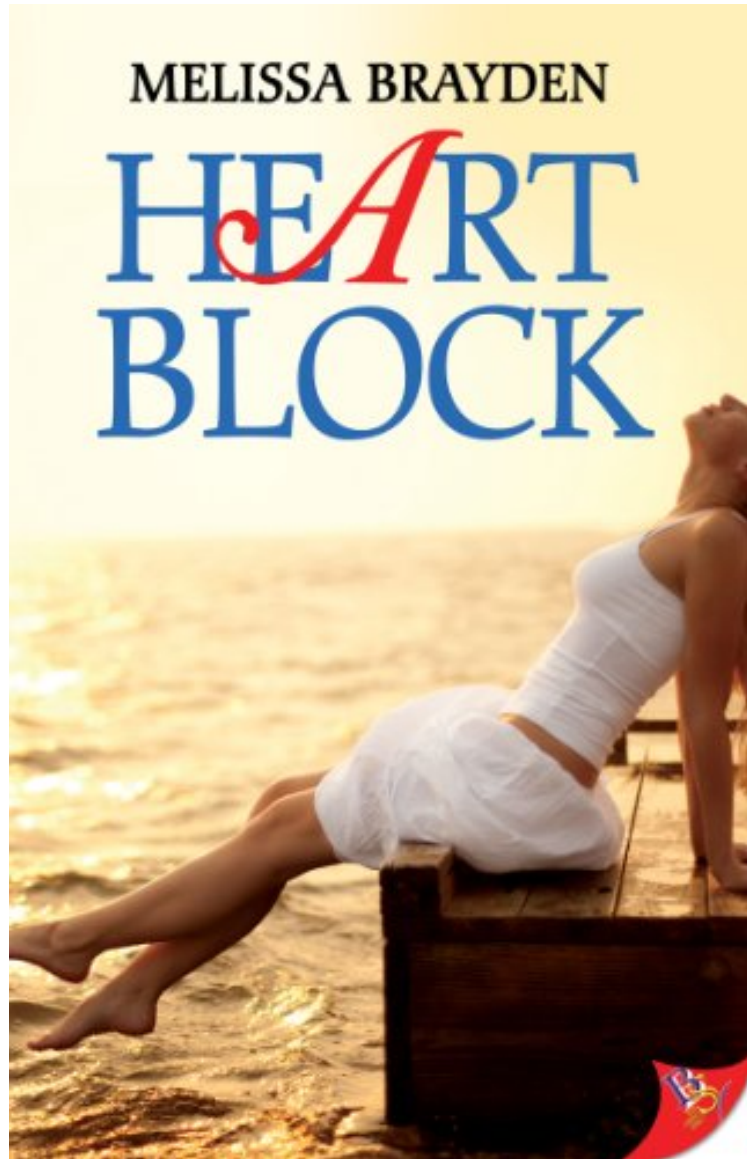

She tries to balance her life around the job, taking care of her eight-year-old daughter Grace and finding enough time for her large Mexican family. When she meets the owner of her newest project, Emory Owen, she's at first taken aback by the aloof, all-business like behaviour of a daughter that has just lost her mother. As time passes, the two so very different women get to know and love each other. But is that enough to overcome the obstacles of two very different worlds?
