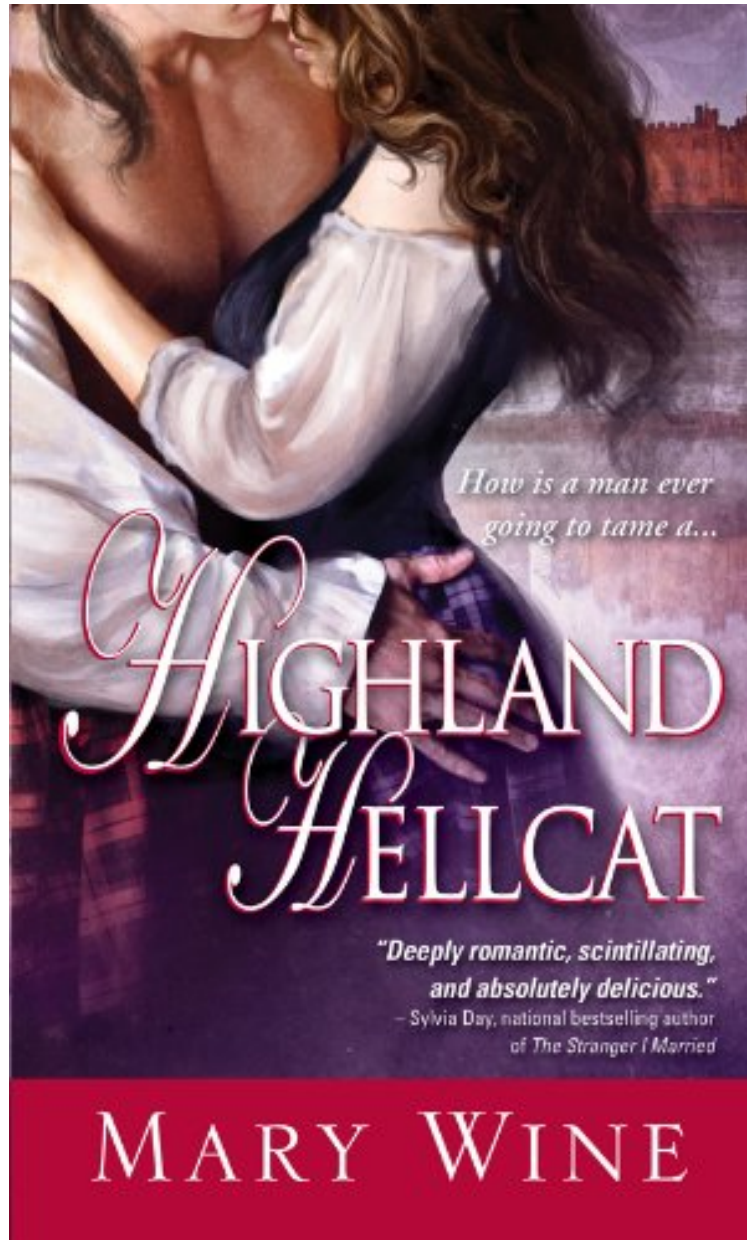

the series Von S. Fischer This book is loosely connected to 'To conquer a highlander', but can be read on its own. As a third daughter, Brina has been promised to the church when she was born. As a result she was raised to be self-sufficient, not very womanly, and she was always kept away from men. But when her older sister takes a lover and is found out, the man she was promised to solves the problem by kidnapping Brina: He wants to marry her instead. Brina finds herself in a conflict: She is strongly attracted to Connor and finds that she enjoys a more earthly life. But she's honorable, too, and she doesn't want to break her father's word. What started out as a way to force a promised alliance and get a pure bride, too, soon turns into love for Connor. So when Brina is kidnapped by another laird and might end up a nun after all, both will have to fight for their love. Von Magritte Highland Hellcat is the second part of Mary Wine's Highlander Saga, which I enjoyed even more than the first part To Conquer a Highlander. Once again the plot is set on a very political background around the childhood of James II of Scotland and the different Highland clans tying alliances. Connor Lindsay is one of these Lairs, he has agreed with Robert Chattan to marry his eldest daughter Deidre; until he finds out that she does not come pure to her marriage having given herself to his enemy. But Connor still needs a pure wife and a daughter of Laird Chattan. When he meets Brina, the youngest of the Chattan Lassies he decides that she will become his wife, being a future bride of Christ, being promised to the church, she is pure, so he does not hesitate and kidnaps her. He does however not expect this woman raised to be a nun to be such a Hellcat with claws and he enjoys waking her passions. Brina however knows that all she owns is her honor and the word she gave her father to become a bride of Christ is worth more to her than any feelings this Highland Laird wakes in her. The characters are really well depicted, tender and savage, understanding and stubborn, Connor and Brina are the perfect Match for one another. The feminine condition is shown here from another point of view, that of a bride of Christ, than in the first book, which was somehow too feminist for me. There were no length in the story, I even think that it could have been a bit longer, adding some more details. Like in the previous book the story has a twist in its last quarter which is really nice to read. This book can be read as a standalone, but I have to admit that I really liked reading the books in order as they make a little more sense and I expect to see Connor's best friend with Brina's sister in the next book: Highland Heat.
