novels, but contribute to an overall story arc. Therefore the installments should be read in the right order and book four is not a good place to start. Review The end of the last book made it clear that the evil sorcerer Samir's apprentices Tessa and Clyde would be on their merry way to eliminate Jade. And cut out her heart for Samir to consume. Or at least for Clyde it's the start of Jade-hunting-season. What Tessa's intentions are, is not so clear. And she, her agenda, pretty fascinating personality and all, makes for a wonderful plot-line. She is very multifaceted and I saw her motivation only after Jade did. Yes, Jade again is this weird, quirky heroine with so much power, a good heart and a strong affinity for the geek-side of pop culture [I wonder what it says about me that I get the references... like.... all of them...]. And I appreciate her for her quick thinking. She never ever does the stupid thing. The dangerous thing, yes. Or the desperate thing. But never does she behave stupid. And here, thankfully, she keeps this up. And she needs her wits about her. The annoying Wylde witches who send bug plagues to get her to leave, definitely are the least of her problems. There are druids, a unicorn and demons. Yes, while Jade learns that there are more supernatural creatures than she knew of, the readers learn too. So the already consistent and rich world building gets even more detailed. The plot turns ever more towards the looming final showdown between Samir and Jade and there is again a final chapter with a POV other than Jade's. It's ominous and makes me wonder how bad it will be for Jade and her friends when the final chapter of this series comes to pass. I don't know why I didn't give five stars, there is a lot to like and it was entertaining and I'm interested in Jade's story. But the book feels a bit rushed. Like the characters being on a race most of the time, nearly never having time to digest what they learned. I don't know.
