HYDE nicht anschließen, mich hat der Roman über weite Strecken einfach nur gelangweilt. Es passiert einfach nichts in dem Buch! Eden und Mitch tun praktisch nichts anderes als sich die ganze Zeit zu unterhalten. Und das Schlimmste ist, dass sie sich über nichts Interessantes unterhalten, nein, sie bewerfen sich nur mit Sarkasmus, dann wird geheult und dann kommt noch mehr Sarkasmus. Wenn ein Buch eine so interessante Prämisse wie HYDE hat, dann erwarte ich, dass sie auch genutzt wird. Es finden kaum Transformationen im Buch statt und die, die wir sehen, sind antiklimatisch. Edens Hyde taucht zwar ein paar Mal auf, aber sie hat mich mal so enttäuscht, und Mitchs Hyde wird für meinen Geschmack auch viel zu sparsam eingesetzt. Es gibt praktisch keine Action im Buch. Unter Urban Fantasy stelle ich mir etwas anderes vor. HYDE würde ich eher unter Romance einordnen. Die Figuren in HYDE haben mich auch nur wenig begeistert. Eden ist ein Waschbären und Mitch hat mich kalt gelassen, was für einen Roman, der sich nur auf die Interaktionen seiner Figuren konzentriert, keine gute Voraussetzung ist. Auch die Liebesgeschichte zwischen Eden und Mitch finde ich nur wenig ansprechend. Mitch verhält sich Eden gegenüber praktisch die ganze Zeit wie ein Depp (was von seiner Warte aus zwar verständlich ist, ihre Reaktion darauf aber nicht erklärt) und trotzdem schmilzt sie in seiner Nähe dahin. Eden ist ein weinerliches Weibchen, das sich von einem Paar starke Beschützerarme in die nächsten schmeißt, und scheinbar gar nichts aus eigener Kraft auf die Reihe bekommt. Blergh!
