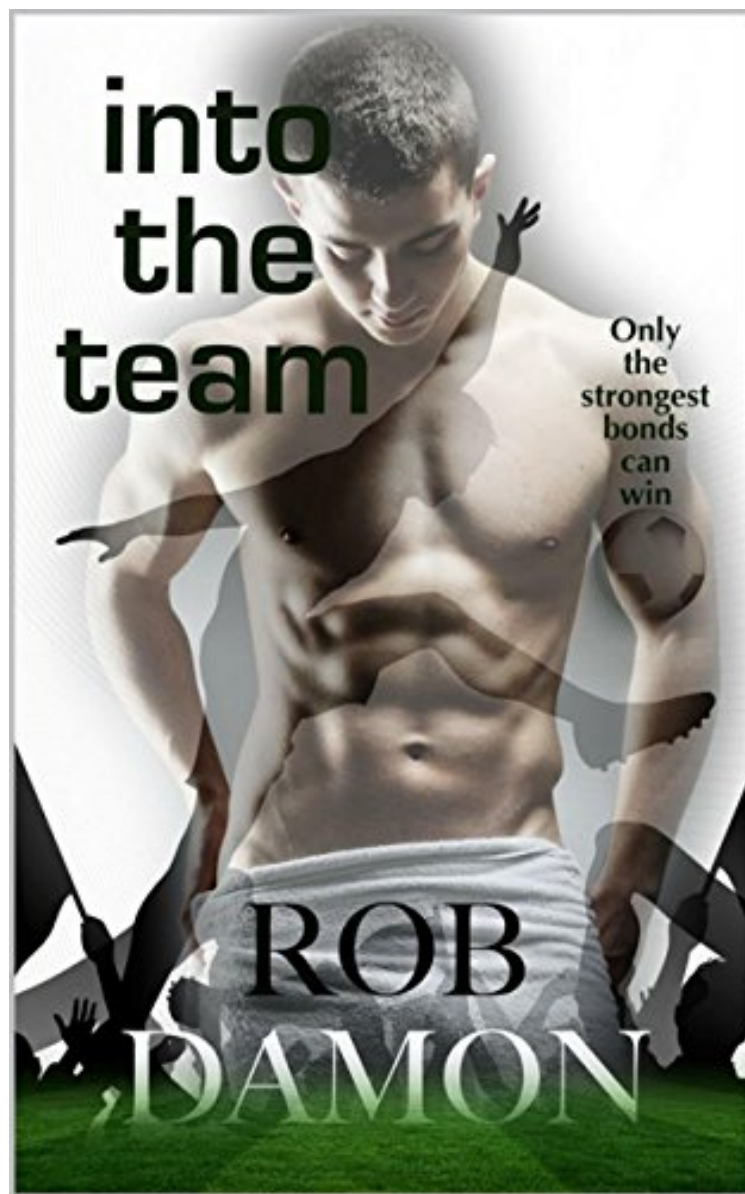

threatening situation to me, as in: you're not allowed to talk to anyone outside the team about your problems anymore, your team is your whole world now, you do the bidding of your manipulative teammates, you forget about all others, and if you can't deal with those intimacies, you have to leave - it felt like some sort of brainwashing cult Todd drifted into. I kept waiting for a conflict, for something to turn bad, for Todd to realize what he wants for himself and make a conscious decision. He did not. He happily drifted through it all, kept his girlfriend, had his partner sort of picked for him and agreed to all challenges, and then the book was over. I liked the initial situation, and the idea behind it, I just couldn't believe the book ended when it did. And, yes, this author has a really negative view on women.

Von Hana-san Ohne zuviel verraten zu wollen, hat diese Story schon eine ganze Portion Cinderella mit im Blut, was den ganzen Fußballzirkus mit seinen Ablufen, Trainings- und Spielpraktiken usw. anbelangt. Aber davon abgesehen erzählt das Buch einförmig, temporeich und leidenschaftlich von Todd Mackerson, der seinen Fußballtraum trotz der etwas "unkonventionellen" Methoden seines neuen Profi-Fußballclubs nicht aufgeben möchte. Das spannungs- und gefühlsreiche der ganzen Angelegenheit spielt sich jedoch zunächst weniger in der "großen" Handlung ab, als mehr zwischen den vielen Figuren, welche zugegebenermaßen einerseits verwirrend viele sind, andererseits schon etwas flach dargestellt werden. Aber die pure Anzahl der Protagonisten hätte wohl sonst alles unnötig in die Länge gezogen; und der Schreibstil von Rob Damon entschuldigt dafür vorzüglich. Man "klickt" mit Todd von Beginn an, und selbst bei Schwerpunktverlagerungen zum Fußball und wieder zurück in persönliche Bereiche folgt man der Handlung mühelos, ohne Spannungsverluste. Trotz des kitschigen Szenarios wären es fünf Sterne. Um die Geschichte in einem Rutsch zu lesen bedarf es keinerlei Kraftanstrengungen, ganz im Gegenteil: mindestens ein Kapitel hätte es schon noch sein dürfen. Das Preis-Leistungs-Verhältnis sieht dagegen weniger rosig aus, denn selbst bei der guten Story ist der Roman relativ teuer. Fazit: Eine tolle Romanze in ausgezeichnetem Erzählstil mit Schwerpunkt auf die Gefühlswelt eines jungen Fußballers, bei der allein der Preis für einen Stern Abzug sorgt. Realitäts-Freunden ist eher abzuraten; aber wer Romantik mit einem Schuß Sportbegeisterung probieren möchte ist hiermit definitiv richtig beraten.
